Please Return Dock Carts to the Gatehouse!



Returning dock carts does more than just save time for your dock mates; it prevents dock carts from being Lost at Sea (or hijacked from the parking lot). Once in a while we recover a few of the ones who end up in the water and they are quite a mess when they are recovered. Please keep in mind that when dock carts are not returned to the gate house, they are more likely to end up in the water, or disappear from the parking lots which cuts down on the number available. Please bring the carts back so we have them ready for use at a central location!

Stuff on the Docks?

If you have any stuff on the docks, please help us out and remove it. Nothing should be stored on the docks but your dock steps (and please don't store any chemicals in or under your steps). The docks are a fire lane that must be kept clear. The maintenance staff may remove things that don't belong (including kayaks & dinghies). Please contact the Harbor Office if you have any questions.
