Major Repair Projects

E-Dock Trash Enclosure – initial approvals are in place and construction is expected to start late September.

Melville Square Parking Lot Repair — slurry coating and restriping for the southern half of the lot is planned for later this summer.

F-Dock Fire Line Replacement – Bellingham Marine will be replacing the fire line on F-Dock later this summer/early fall. Water service will be disrupted periodically during the project while they install the new lines.

E-Dock End Tie Waler Replacement – several end-ties on the west side of E-Dock will have their walers replaced in the fall. If you are not on or next to the affected end-ties the main impact will be brief disruptions to water and power.

Power Center Remote Ground Fault Monitoring Equipment – Remote monitoring equipment is being installed in the newer Eaton power centers. Once we have the equipment installed and online, those power centers will have the capability to detect ground faults originating from vessels. This will provide better reporting and the ability to isolate boats that are exceeding the allowable current. All new power centers will come with this equipment pre-installed. With 800 slips, it will take a number of years to completely retrofit the entire marina.

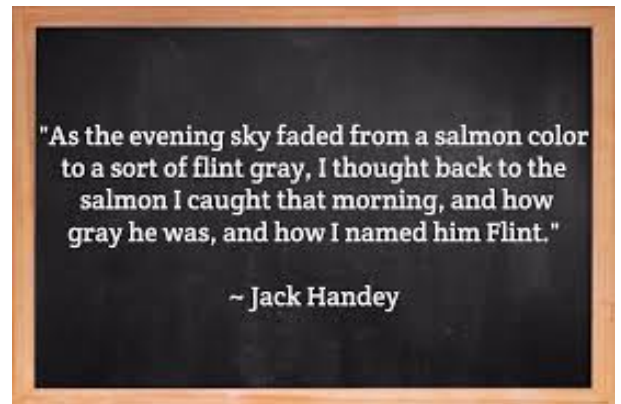
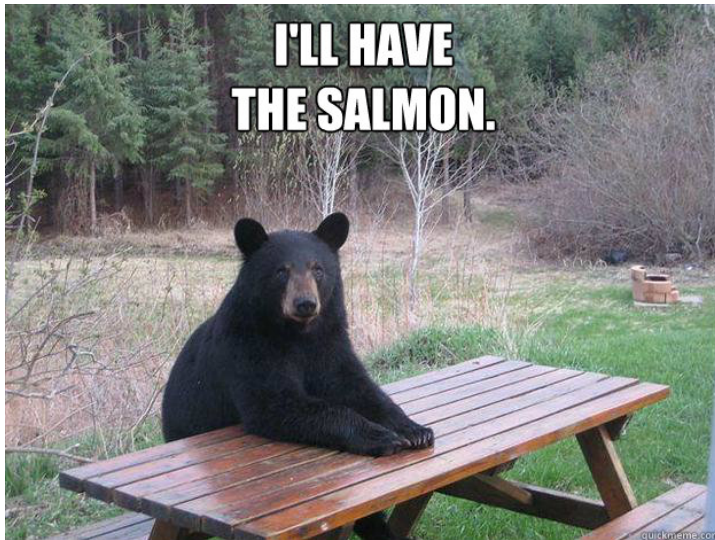
