Please Display Your Parking Permit

Help make sure there is ample parking at the marina for boaters and guests by properly displaying your permit. **The proper location for your permit is on the LEFT REAR bumper or window.** If you display your permit in another location we cannot guarantee that it will be seen and you won't inadvertently get ticketed.

The 2019 Parking Permit forms will be sent out in early October. As of January 1, 2019 all previous permits will no longer be valid & vehicles displaying them may be subject to citation and/or towing.

If you are having a guest for more than a day sail, please stop by the office to pick up a yellow visitor's permit. We strongly encourage carpooling whenever possible, particularly on busy weekends.

Calling Emergency Services

When you call 9-1-1 or RPD Dispatch (510- 233-1214) for a fire, medical emergency, or suspected crime it is vital that you are able to give accurate directions to the dispatcher. Don't assume that they are familiar with the marina layout. Be clear and accurate in your directions:

- Tell them what dock you are on (D, E, F or G Dock) at Marina Bay Yacht Harbor!
- Tell them the street your dock is on:
 - D-Dock is on Spinnaker Way
 - E-Dock is on Esplanade Drive & Melville Square
 - F & G Docks are on Hall Avenue
- Tell them the slip number or location where the emergency is.
