Liveaboard Status

Temporary liveaboard status for those displaced by the recent fires Contact the Harbor Office

If anyone has been displaced by the recent fires and needs temporary liveaboard status, please contact the Harbor Office for availability ASAP.

As a reminder, living aboard without authorization from the Marina is a breach of the Berth License Agreement and grounds for termination. Don't do it! Talk to us first, otherwise our options become severely limited. The Marina is bound by the terms of our permits and lease & City code limiting the number of legal liveaboards.

Winter Is COMING. . . Get your boat ready!



Please secure your vessel for winter weather!

- **Make sure your roller furling headsail won't unfurl in the winds! Better yet, take it down if you won't be going sailing for a while!** Seriously, take it down. Don't be *that guy* in the next storm. It's dangerous when it breaks loose in a storm and can cause a lot of damage to your boat. Your neighbors will thank you.
 - Replace dock lines and chafing gear and **add spring** lines where needed.
 - Ensure that the power cord to your boat is in good condition (check both ends and your boat inlet!), is securely plugged in to both the dock box and your vessel, & has enough slack for vessel movement.
 - Ensure that cockpit drains are clear and hatches are closed.
 - Be prepared for deck leaks and make sure your automatic bilge pump is in good working order.
 - Make sure you do not have oil or fuel in your bilge!
 - Let the Harbor Office know if you have any loose or damaged cleats in your slip.
 - Make sure sail covers, awnings, dinghies and other gear are properly secured.
- And lastly, but most importantly, **check your boat often**, particularly before and after each storm!

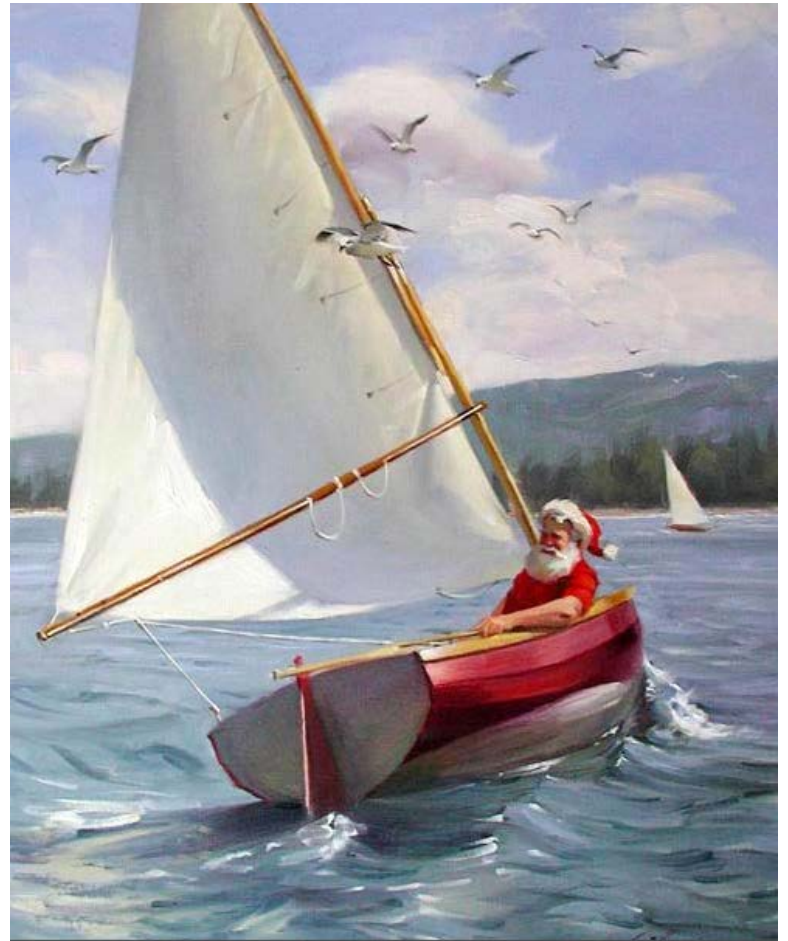
