Insurance



It's one of those things that aren't too exciting until you really need it. Part of the requirement for berthing at the marina is providing proof of minimum insurance coverage. That includes providing updates whenever your policy is renewed or you change insurers.

The requirement to list the Marina as "Additionally Insured" on your policy means that your insurer *should* send us updates automatically, however this does not always happen for a number of reasons. Sometimes we do not receive it because the insurer has the incorrect address, or the insurance is under a different name than the Berth License Agreement. Other times it is just one of the mysteries of the industry. . .



If the certificate we have on file has expired, you will receive a notification on your monthly statement. We will also use email and mail and phone calls to notify you.

When sending us copies of your insurance, email to info@mbyachtharbor.com is the best. A copy of your declaration page and the Additional Insured endorsement are usually sufficient however every insurer is a little different in how they present the coverage information so it can be a little confusing.

Coverage under an umbrella policy or homeowner's policy can be more complicated and might require additional paperwork. Liveaboards must provide written evidence that liveboard usage is covered (some insurers like Progressive will not cover liveboard usage).

Please Display Your Parking Permit

The 2019 Parking Permit forms have been sent to everyone who already submitted their forms.

As of January 1, 2019 all previous permits will no longer be valid & vehicles displaying them may be subject to citation and/or towing.

Electrical Safety

Please be extremely careful with electric heaters on board! Heaters and dehumidifiers can draw a very large load so be careful that you do not overload your boat's wiring. Also keep in mind that electric heaters can have a big impact on your electric bill!

Carefully inspect all wiring and your shore power connections. As a reminder, all shore power connections must be UL approved marine type and the use of adaptors to connect household type extension cords is prohibited (adaptors are NOT UL approved). The Marina reserves the right to ban any cords we deem unsuitable.

And of course, never leave heaters on unattended! As Smokey the Boating Bear says:
