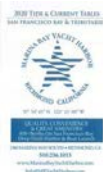

Insurance



It's one of those things that aren't too exciting until you really need it. Part of the requirement for berthing at the marina is providing proof of minimum insurance coverage. That includes providing updates whenever your policy is renewed or you change insurers.

2020 Tidebooks



The 2020 Tidebooks are here. Copies are available at the Harbor Office and other key locations in the Marina.

The requirement to list the Marina as "Additionally Insured" on your policy means that your insurer *should* send us updates automatically, however this does not always happen for a number of reasons. Sometimes we do not receive it because the insurer has the incorrect address, or the insurance is under a different name than the Berth License Agreement. Other times it is just one of the mysteries of the industry. . .

Please Display Your Parking Permit



As of January 1, 2020 all previous years permits will no longer be valid & vehicles displaying them may be subject to citation and/or towing.



If the certificate we have on file has expired, you will receive a notification on your monthly statement. We will also use email and mail and phone calls to notify you.

Protect your Shorepower Cord, prevent damage to your boat!



Shut off the breaker at the dock box every time you plug or unplug your shorepower cord!

Plugging or unplugging energized power cords can damage them which can lead to damage to your boat's electrical system or fires. Inspect your cord and inlet regularly for any signs of damage.

If your power center has a 20 Amp dock light breaker, please leave that ON!

When sending us copies of your insurance, email to info@mbyachtharbor.com is the best. A copy of your declaration page and the Additional Insured endorsement are usually sufficient however every insurer is a little different in how they present the coverage information so it can be a little confusing.

Coverage under an umbrella policy or homeowner's policy can be more complicated and might require additional paperwork. Liveaboards must provide written evidence that liveaboard usage is covered (some insurers like Progressive will not cover liveaboard usage).
