## Please Display Your Parking Permit

Help make sure there is ample parking at the marina for boaters and guests by properly displaying your permit. **The proper location for your permit is on the LEFT REAR bumper or window.** If you display your permit in another location we cannot guarantee that it will be seen and you won't inadvertently get ticketed.

**The 2021 Parking Permit forms have been mailed. Please complete and return your form to get your 2021 permit.**

**As of January 1, 2021 all previous permits will no longer be valid & vehicles displaying them may be subject to citation and/or towing.**

**(You do not need to wait until January 1 to display your 2021 permit, they are valid immediately)**

If you are having a guest for more than a day sail, please stop by the office to pick up a yellow visitor's permit. We strongly encourage carpooling whenever possible, particularly on busy weekends.



## DOCK CARTS

It often seems like there are never enough to go around: We need everyone's help in taking care of them.

- Please Return All Carts to the Head of the Dock! Don't leave them in the parking lots, or by the slips. No one enjoys having to search through the marina to find a cart!
- Please Don't Overload the Carts! (ie NO engine blocks, loads of anchor chain or batteries!).



Please take steps to secure your vessel for the coming winter weather!

- Be prepared for deck leaks and make sure your automatic bilge pump is in good working order.
- **Make sure you do not have oil or fuel in your bilge!**
- Ensure that cockpit drains are clear and hatches are secure.
- Ensure that the power cord to your boat is in good condition (check both ends and your boat inlet!), is securely plugged in to both the dock box and your vessel, & it has enough slack for vessel movement.
- Replace dock lines and chafing gear and **add spring** lines where needed.
- Let the Harbor Office know if you have any loose or damaged cleats in your slip.
- Make sure sail covers and awnings are properly secured.
- Make sure your roller furling headsail won't unfurl in the winds! Better yet, take it down if you won't be going for a sail for a while!
- Make sure dinghies and other gear are properly secured or put away for the winter.

And lastly, but most importantly, **check your boat often**, particularly before and after each storm!
