No Hazardous Waste in Dock boxes or Under Dock Steps (or anywhere else on the dock)!

We know it's tempting; there is often that leftover bit of varnish or partially used bottle of oil that you want to hang on to for later use. But storing these items on the dock increases the chances of leaks and spills in the water. And the hazmat all too often gets forgotten until it leaks and makes a sticky mess all over everything else in the dock box.

The Marina Rules State:

5. STORAGE ON DOCKS. Storage of items must be confined to the dock box or the boat . . . Storage of hazardous or flammable materials is not allowed on or about the docks or in dock boxes. Any unapproved items found on a walkway or finger pier will be removed and disposed of at Boat Owner's risk and expense. . .

The waste oil recycling sheds are in the courtyard at D-Dock and the Launch Ramp Parking lot. We can recycle used motor oil, filters and dispose of used absorbents. **As always, please do not leave oil or filters outside! Please call the Harbor Office for access. Containers left outside can spill which pretty much defeats the purpose of the recycling.**

If you need to dispose of other waste, such as used paint thinner, acetone, old paint & varnish, or other hazardous substances, please use the **West County Household Hazardous Waste Collection Facility** located at 101 Pittsburg Ave., Richmond 94801. Stuff on the Docks?

If you have any stuff on the docks, please help us out and remove it. Nothing should be stored on the docks but your dock steps. The docks are a fire lane that must be kept clear. Security Alert



There has been an uptick in thefts in the Bay Area, particularly catalytic converters from certain vehicles but also general break ins and theft. Don't make it easy on the criminals – secure your belongings, move your vehicle frequently and report suspicious activity to RPD.

Keep a list of valuables including model and serial numbers of items. The police can't help retrieve anything if they can't determine that it was stolen.

And we understand the frustration and the feeling that the police "won't do anything" but if crimes are not reported to RPD, the criminals will keep on coming back as long as they think there is something to steal. So please, even if it's minor take the time to report it online at least:
