The Yellow Zone is for Loading and unloading only. . .

The loading zones at the Marina, particularly at D & E Docks, sometimes get abused with vehicles parking there for extended periods blocking others from unloading.

Below is the City code on yellow zones, since the spaces are not otherwise marked the limit is actually only 3 minutes! So if you exceed that time RPD may ticket you.

From Richmond Municipal Code:

14.48.020 - Curb markings to indicate no stopping and parking regulations.

The Director of Public Works is authorized, subject to the provisions and limitations of this article, to place, and when required by this chapter, shall place, the following curb markings to indicate parking or standing regulations, and said curb markings shall have the meaning as set forth in this section:

(b) Yellow shall mean no stopping, standing or parking at any time between seven a.m. and six p.m. of any day except Sundays and holidays for any purpose other than the loading or unloading of passengers or materials; provided, that the loading or unloading of passengers shall not consume more than three minutes nor the loading or unloading of materials more than twenty minutes for commercial vehicles or no more than three minutes for passenger vehicles. The only exceptions are:

(1) Where a yellow loading zone is clearly marked by signs which indicate that it is a special loading zone, the restrictions on stopping, standing or parking shall apply at all times.

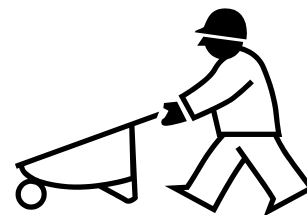
All Pets Must Be On Leash

DOCK CARTS

- Please Return All Carts to the Head of the Dock! Don't leave them in the parking lots, or by the slips. No one enjoys having to search through the marina to find a cart!
- Please Don't Overload the Carts! (ie NO engine blocks, loads of anchor chain or batteries!).
- Don't leave them blocking the dumpsters (E-Dock especially! Blocking the dumpsters can mean the trash pickup gets skipped!

If you want to keep a cart for your exclusive use at your slip, consider buying one of the nifty folding varieties available at marine chandleries & online.

Stuff on the Docks?

If you have any stuff on the docks, please help us out and remove it. Nothing should be stored on the docks but your dock steps. The docks are a fire lane that must be kept clear. The maintenance staff may remove things that don't belong (including kayaks & dinghies). Please contact the Harbor Office if you have any questions.
