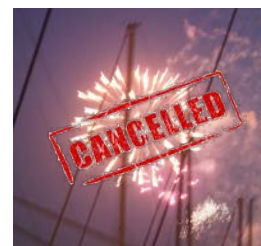

Please use nozzles on hoses and when washing your boats, use buckets where ever possible rather than free-flowing hose. Take shorter showers (turn the water off while soaping up), don't allow the sink water to run while brushing your teeth or shaving. Also, please help the marina conserve by reporting leaks on the dock.
