E-Dock Waterline Replacement

In October we will begin the long delayed process of replacing all the water & fire lines on E-Dock. This is a long-over due project and the frequent waterline breaks on E-Dock are apparently nature's way of saying we are well past the end of the effective life span of the existing water supply system. The contractor will make up the HDPE pipe on the dock first before submerging it and installing it under the dock. There will be extended periods of time where water will be off to sections of the dock when they are removing the old pipe and installing the new.

We will do our best to minimize the disruption and give as much notice as possible but **we encourage everyone to fill up their tanks in advance** or be prepared to do without until the water can be restored to their section of dock. Of course boaters are welcome to come by the Harbormaster dock or pumpout docks to top up their tanks as well.

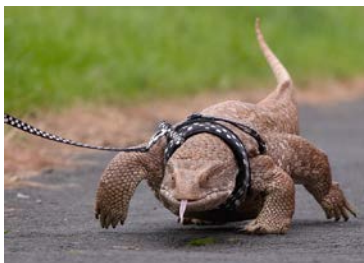
Recycling
