Billing Schedule

Berth rent is due on the 1st of each month. The monthly statements are sent out around the 21st of the month so there is time to review the pending charges. If you don't see your statement, please check your SPAM filter and check with the Harbor Office to make sure we have your correct e-mail address. Late fees are applied to any past due balances not paid by the 10th of the month.

Daylight Saving Time starts March 13
More daylight to enjoy your boat!

Protect your Shorepower Cord, prevent damage to your boat!



Shut off the breaker at the dock box every time you plug or unplug your shorepower cord!

Plugging or unplugging energized power cords can damage them which can lead to damage to your boat's electrical system or fires.

Make sure your cords do not dangle in the water!

Please leave the 20 Amp dock light breaker ON if your power center has one.



The Yellow Zone is for Loading and unloading only. . .

The loading zones at the Marina, particularly at D & E Docks, sometimes get abused with vehicles parking there for extended periods blocking others from unloading.

Below is the City code on yellow zones, since the spaces are not otherwise marked the limit is actually only 3 minutes! So if you exceed that time RPD may ticket you.

From Richmond Municipal Code:

14.48.020 - Curb markings to indicate no stopping and parking regulations.

The Director of Public Works is authorized, subject to the provisions and limitations of this article, to place, and when required by this chapter, shall place, the following curb markings to indicate parking or standing regulations, and said curb markings shall have the meaning as set forth in this section:

(b) **Yellow shall mean no stopping, standing or parking at any time between seven a.m. and six p.m. of any day except Sundays and holidays for any purpose other than the loading or unloading of passengers or materials; provided, that the loading or unloading of passengers shall not consume more than three minutes nor the loading or unloading of materials more than twenty minutes for commercial vehicles or no more than three minutes for passenger vehicles. The only exceptions are:**

(1) Where a yellow loading zone is clearly marked by signs which indicate that it is a special loading zone, the restrictions on stopping, standing or parking shall apply at all times.



Changing your oil?

The Marina has facilities to recycle used motor oil and filters and to dispose of used absorbent pads at the Launch Ramp & D Dock. Contact the Harbor Office for access (Please don't just leave the containers outside the sheds where they may get spilled). Please do not mix anything with the oil, especially any coolant, fuel, brake cleaner or other solvents. For info on how to safely dispose of any other hazardous items go to: www.recyclemore.com.






