## Commercial Activity

Charters, Sport Fishing etc.

Commercial activity at the Marina is not permitted without written authorization from the Marina (RMC 5.16.090.f & Section 9.f of the Berth License Agreement). Please contact the office BEFORE conducting any commercial activity at the Marina.

Boarding or landing passengers at a vessel's slip in particular is prohibited and there is a \$100 fine per violation in place. So an unauthorized 6-pack charter on the dock risks being fined for each passenger boarding or landing — potentially \$1200 for one trip. With any fines levied against a vessel, the Marina will apply any payments made to the fines first and then, if there is any money left over, to berth rent. Unpaid berth rent leaves a vessel open to arrest and foreclosure in federal court so violating the rules will get very expensive very quickly.

So it will be much cheaper and easier for anyone who wants to conduct commercial activity at the Marina to contact the Harbor Office in advance and ensure they have completed all the necessary steps to get written authorization to do so.

## Dumpsters



Please do not contaminate the recycling bins with non-recyclables! "Wishful Recycling" tends to do more harm than good when we toss items that we wish would be recycled into the bins we risk contaminating the entire load that can then just end up in the landfill instead.

- Please place only recyclable items in the recycling dumpsters. All other trash goes in the other bins.
- Please close the dumpster lids when you are finished. Open lids allows trash to spread!
- Please Do Not block the dumpsters with dock carts or debris. Blocked dumpsters don't get picked up and end up overflowing.
- Please take all hazardous waste items such as chemicals, batteries or electronics to the Household Hazardous Waste Facility.
