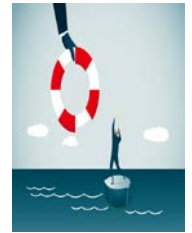

## 2023 Parking Permit

The 2023 Parking Permit forms are being mailed. Please complete and return your form to get your 2023 permit.

As of January 1, 2023 all previous permits will no longer be valid & vehicles displaying them may be subject to citation and/or towing.

(You do not need to wait until January 1 to display your 2023 permit, they are valid immediately)



## Current Documentation or Registration & Insurance

The Berth License Agreement requires boat owners submit current Documentation or Registration as well as current Insurance upon renewal. While the office may have not routinely bugged people in the past for updated copies that hasn't changed the requirement and we need to update our records. Notices have been going out to accounts with expired or missing documentation or registration.

Documentation is with the US Coast Guard and has been an annual renewal in the past however in recent years, they have been offering multi-year (up to 5 years) renewal. When renewing documentation, be aware of commercial sites that look like the official Coast Guard site (& charge a lot more). Registration is with California DMV and is valid for two years with renewal on odd years.

A surprising number of people have allowed their documentation or registration to expire, sometimes for a very long time. As office staff sometimes need to spend an inordinate amount of time chasing down current paperwork from a few, we have instituted a new fee on our rate schedule of \$100 per month for vessels who fail to provide current documentation or registration despite multiple requests. The fee for expired insurance is \$50 per day. While we would prefer to update our records, the new fees provide an alternative for those who do not share our priority.
