Please check your SPAM folder and make sure that e-mails from SHMarina.com are permitted so you don't miss any key messages. With the new contracts we have the ability to do online signatures which is a big improvement over past efforts. If you have previously already submitted the auto pay info and don't wish to repeat it on your contract just fill out the auto pay info with all "9"s (since the field is required).

Accounts that we are unable to get a signed contract for in a timely fashion may be liable for transient berth rent at the daily rate. Please return your signed contract ASAP if you haven't already!

The marina's annual fire extinguisher inspection will be Thursday, May 4 and Friday, May 5 at the Harbormaster's office. Stop by the Harbor Office Shop during this time to deliver your extinguishers directly to the service technician or drop them off in advance. The Marina will cover the basic service certification for standard ABC extinguishers. If your extinguishers require more service, you can negotiate that directly with the technician. Please make sure to clearly label any fire extinguisher left with the office. Include your name, slip number and phone number. For more information, contact the Harbor Office.
