
## SAFE HARBOR - MARINA BAY YACHT HARBOR -Marina Bay Tides -Febru

February 2024



Due to recent large rate increases from PGE, electric bills may seem higher than expected. The PGE rate for the first 335 KWh has increased to \$0.42 per KWh, usage over 335 KWh is \$0.52/ KWh.

When comparing bills from different periods it is most accurate to compare the KWh usage rather than the total dollar amount. If the usage is similar then the difference in cost would be due to any rate changes rather than changes in use.



We know it's tempting; there is often that leftover bit of varnish or partially used bottle of oil that you want to hang on to for later use. But storing these items on the dock increases the chances of leaks and spills in the water. And the hazmat all too often gets forgotten until it leaks and makes a sticky mess all over everything else in the dock box.

The waste oil recycling sheds are in the courtyard at D-Dock and the Launch Ramp Parking lot. We can recycle used motor oil, filters and dispose of used absorbents. *As always, please do not leave oil or filters outside! Please call the Harbor Office for access.*

#### Do we have your Current Documentation or Registration?

All California registrations expire as of December 31, 2023. Make sure we get a copy of your updated registration!

The Slip Agreement requires boat owners to submit current Documentation or Registration. Registration is with California DMV and is valid for two years with renewal on odd years.

Documentation with the Coast Guard can be valid for one to five years and may expire any time of the depending on when first issued.

There is a monthly "inconvenience fee" of \$100 per month for members who are unable to provide a copy of current vessel Documentation or Registration in a timely fashion. In most cases, the actual documentation or registration fee will be substantially less so providing the update is cheaper. *"Sort've an incentive kind of a deal, huh?"* – Captain Ron


